The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request received December 7, 2009. The project known as the U.S. 98 project is located along US 98 from Navy Boulevard to Blue Angel Boulevard, in Sections 21, 22 and 23, Township 2 South, Range 30 West, and Sections 50 and 53, Township 2 South, Range 31 West, Escambia County, Florida.

The proposed modification is to change the mitigation condition. The condition is modified to change the required acquisition of 350 acres at Jones Swamp to the debit of 19.43 credits from the Dutex property ledger.


