RE: Approval of the Release of Canal Reservation

DATE: October 13, 2020

#### **Summary**

Historically, when conveying land from the state to private parties, the State of Florida Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund (Trustees) reserved unto the state the right to construct "canals, cuts, sluice-ways, dikes and other works...for the drainage or reclamation" of other land owned by the state. These reservations (known as "canal reservations") are largely unnecessary today in light of current policy requiring the protection of wetlands, instead of draining the land; however, the reservations remain in the chains of title of the affected land. If a current owner of land burdened by such reservations wants the reservations released, it makes a request to the Trustees for a release. The Trustees require the District to review and issue a written approval to DEP prior to releasing canal reservations.

The District has been asked to approve the release of a canal reservation upon a tract of land in Bay County, which is currently owned by LMWS, LLC (which appears to be affiliated with The St. Joe Company). The property is located in Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 16 West, which is north of the Intracoastal Waterway and west of Highway 79.

Pursuant to Section 373.096, Florida Statutes, the Governing Board may release any reservation for which it has no present or apparent future use under terms and conditions determined by the Board. The request has been reviewed by the District's Resource Management Division and legal counsel, and approval by way of Governing Board resolution is recommended.

#### **Recommendation**

It is the recommendation of District staff and District legal counsel that the Governing Board approve the attached resolution releasing the canal reservation and enter it into the records of the District.
